having your parents with you on a mission trip doesn't sound like fun, I have found it enhances the experience for everyone involved.

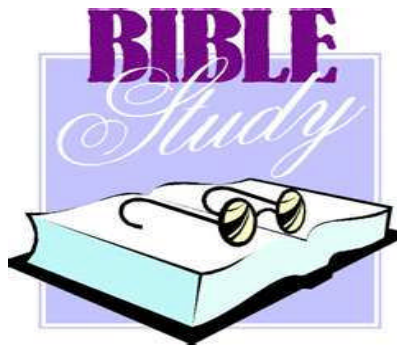
